Wheatland City Council Proceedings March 14, 2016

Mayor Schnede called the regular meeting of the Wheatland City Council to order at 6:30 p.m. with council members Bousselot, P. Stankee, Wiese, Denahy and C. Stankee present. Also present were city employees Laurie Ganzer and Matt Cavey.

Public forum – no oral or written comments were made.

The **railroad bridge funds** were discussed. Various steps need to be taken before the money will be available to the City. A motion to hire Calhoun & Burns as engineer for the project was made by P. Stankee with a second by Denahy. All ayes.

A motion to approve the street closing for QC Networks on May 14th for a customer appreciation day was made by P. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

A motion to approve the 1st reading of **ordinance 169-16** which is for a water rate increase effective July 1, 2016 was made by P. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

A motion to approve the 1st reading of **ordinance 170-16** which is for the garbage rate increase which will be effective July 1, 2016 was made by P. Stankee with a second by Bousselot. All ayes.

The drainage issues in front of City Hall were discussed.

A motion to approve an annual stipend to the Pine Hill Cemetery and the St. Paul's cemetery which matches the funds that are given by the County for Veteran's buried in the cemetery was made by P. Stankee with a second by Denahy. All ayes.

A motion to approve a fence permit for 411 Main Street was made by P. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

WGML Refuse – a new truck has been ordered. The cost is \$83,605.00. Ganzer discussed purchase of cans that can be used with the arm. The cans are expensive but if a monthly fee is added to utility accounts for 12 equal payments rather than citizen's being expected to pay for the can in one fee. Another option would be for the city to pay for the cans and they remain with the property if when someone moves.

A motion to approve the **Junior Achievement proclamation** noting April 7th as Junior Achievement day was made by P. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

The Clinton County Sheriff's Office spent 75.45 hours in the city of Wheatland from January 26, 2016 through February 25, 2016 while on patrol they issued 3 warnings, 1 citation, handled 4 incidents and answered 8 calls.
