

WHEATLAND CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING
BUDGET WORKSHOP
January 23, 2008
6:00 p.m.

Mayor Pro Tem Schnede called the special meeting of the Wheatland City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Wheatland City Hall with council members Prachar, Schnede, Rohling and Patterson present. Also present were city employees Matt Cavey and Laurie Ganzer, Fire Chief Pat Steward, Fireman Jess Heileman and several other members of the public.

At a hearing requested by Paul Stankee regarding the removal of his dog from Wheatland City limits due to a complaint filed by Mary Dewys on January 11, 2008 in which Mr. Stankee's dog was at large and attacked her dog while it was tied out on the Dewys property. Mr. Stankee did not feel that his dog should be considered a dangerous animal. Mr. Stankee felt that the situation was not handled properly. The Council informed Mr. Stankee that they did not agree with his findings and would seek to have the animal removed, until such time the animal will need to be quarantined at an appropriate facility. Stankee then asked who's responsibility it would be to pay the impoundment fees. Council member Schnede will contact the City attorney on January 24, 2008 to inquire about the financial responsibility for the containment fees and any other costs incurred while the situation is being reviewed.

A motion to purchase pizza was made by Prachar with a second by Rohling. All ayes.

The remainder of the meeting was used for working on the 2009 proposed budget.

A motion to adjourn at 10:00 p.m. was made by Rohling with a second by Patterson. All ayes.
