

Wheatland City Council Proceedings
March 13, 2017

Mayor Schnede called the regular meeting of the Wheatland City Council to order at 6:30 p.m. with council members P. Stankee, Boussetot, C. Stankee, Denahy and Wiese present. Also present were city employees Laurie Ganzer and Matt Cavey.

John Kraye of MSA Professionals was present to discuss the replacement of the **Jefferson St bridge**. A motion to approve a contract with MSA Professionals for \$2,500.00 for design & planning was made by Wiese with a second by C. Stankee. All ayes.

Tile at the compost pile. – no action was taken.

Skidloader bids – no action was taken

A motion to approve resolution 2017 – 19 which is for the approval of the Clinton County Hazardous Mitigation Plan was made by P. Stankee with a second by Denahy. All ayes.

A motion to approve Paul Stankee as the **Fire Chief** was made by Denahy with a second by Wiese. Ayes – Denahy, Boussetot and Wiese. Abstain – P. Stankee and C. Stankee.

The lease agreement between the City and the Community Hall Board was reviewed. Suggestions or changes will be submitted to the Clerk by March 30th.

The **Clinton County Sheriff Office** spent 63.05 hours in the city of Wheatland from January 26, 2017 through February 26, 2017 while on patrol they issued 2 warnings, 6 citations, answered 4 calls and handled 4 incidents.
