## CHAPTER 92, CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF WHEATLAND

## 92.08 CUSTOMER DEPOSITS

Customer deposits shall be required of all new customers who are tenants or new homeowners, and of those who have unacceptable credit record or who have a prior record of failure to pay water bills rendered. Such deposits shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Deposit for renters shall be one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).

When a customer moves out, such customer must come to City Hall and leave a forwarding address with the Clerk. When the customer's final utility bill has been paid, the customer will get the deposit back. Deposits of homeowners having established acceptable credit records for three years shall be returned. A occurrence or recurrence of a bad payment record may be the occasion for the Clerk to require a new or larger deposit for the continuation of service.
